Characteristic features:

- ✔ Steel toe cap (SB).
- ✔ Class 0 electro-insulating properties.
- ✔ Puncture resistant sole (P).
- ✔ Slip resistance (SR) and resistance to fuel oil (FO).
- ✔ High temperature resistance (HRO) - uppers resistant to flame and radiant heat.
- ✔ Heel section energy absorption above 20 J (E).
- ✔ Sole insulation against heat (HI).
- ✔ Protection against water ingress.
