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Qur'an Recitation Skills (Level 1) (TAJWĪD)

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Introduction

The science of *Tajwīd* has long been a matter of debate among Muslim scientists and thinkers. This science was established as a means of providing the right method of reciting the Qur'an according to the articulate Arabic language. The science of *Tajwīd* endeavors to describe Arabic voices in a way that corresponds to the criteria of the articulate and accurate recitation of the Qur'an. Articulate recitation descends from the recitation of the great reciters, the pioneers of recitation, and Arab orators who were responsible for the instruction of the Holy Qur'an at the time they constituted the science of *Tajwīd*. The proportionate recitation and perfect pronunciation of the Qur'an has the power of revealing more dimensions of the prophetic nature and oratorical language of this divine book. The great Prophet of Islam himself used to recite the Qur'an and, thus, Muslims also undertook to recite the Holy Book by employing accurate articulation and a good voice. *The Science of Tajwīd* intends to instruct the knowledge and skills of *Tajwīd*. In this work, the achievements of modern Arabic phonetics, acoustics, and anatomy have been incorporated in addition to authorized sources on the science of *Tajwīd* and *qirā'at*. This work has been produced by Dr. Mohammad Reza Sotoudehnia, member of the Faculty of Theology, a referee of international competitions of the Qur'an, and an expert in the instruction of skills for the recitation of the Qur'an.
